





- June 2021: GMCS endorsed by National Quality Forum Consensus Standards Approval Committee
- August 2022: Global Malnutrition Composite Score (GMCS) published in CMS Final Rule for inpatient and longterm hospitals

FY 2023 IPPS final rule was released on 08/01/2022

Contains exciting updates to the Hospital IQR Program with specific implications for RDNs

PRACTICE TIPS: Addressing Food and Nutrition Insecurity STEPS to identify and address Food Insecurity and Malnutrition

- Step 1: Review definitions for food and nutrition insecurity and related terms
- Step 2: Understand Academy and other resources to strengthen individual competence related addressing food insecure populations
- Step 3: Determine if patient/client is food insecure by conducting a food insecurity screening
- Step 4: Identify if additional RDN follow-up is needed and determine nutrition intervention/pla care
- Step 5: Direct coordination of care by RDN

*All registered dietitians are nutritionists, but not all nutritionists are registered dietitians. The Academy's Board of Directors and Commission on Dietetic Registration have determined that those who hold the cre Registered Dietitian (RD) may optionally use "Registered Dietitian Nutritionist" (RDN) instead. The two credentials have identical meanings. In this Practice Tips, the Quality Management Committee has chose use the term RDN to refer to both registered dietitians and registered dietitian nutritionists and to use the NDTR to refer to both dietetic technician, registered and nutrition and dietetics technician, registered.






